Day's Schedule - November 10, 2007

12:00 - 1:00 pm	Enter item at Mansfield Park Rec Center Hall. Entries will NOT be accepted after 1 pm
1:30 pm	Judging of Bake Show items - not open to the public
5:30 pm	Public Viewing of Bake Show items Post results
6:00 pm	Auction

General BCJLS Rules - **See New Rules Changes**

1. All exhibitors must be academically eligible to exhibit his/her project.
2. Entries and fees must be received by the Family & Consumer Science Teacher or County Extension Agent - FCS **no later than October 25, 2007 at 12:00 noon**. Entries received after 12:00 noon on October 25th will be charged a \$25.00 late fee in addition to the \$10 entry fee until October 29th. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 12:00 NOON on October 29th!**

3. Decision of the judges will be final. Anyone making a protest must pay a \$25 filing fee. Protest will be made to the Board of Directors. If the protest is won, the \$25 filing fee will be refunded. If the protest is lost, the filing fee will go to the show fund. Protest will not be considered unless the \$25 fee has been placed with the Division Superintendent.

4. Exhibitors checks will be distributed by the FCS teachers and CEA on **December 15, 2007**. Exhibitor MUST bring a written 'thank you' note in an unsealed, stamped envelope for their buyer. Exhibitor must also bring a written 'thank you' note to their trophy sponsor, if they received one. Names/addresses can be obtained from the Extension Office or your FCS teacher.

Bake Show Rules

1. All contestants must meet at least one of the following criteria:

A. Active 4-H member enrolled by October 1, 2007 in a Foods & Nutrition project.

B. Students who have met educational requirements in Foods & Nutrition in a Family & Consumer Science class in school under the direction of a FCS teacher.

C. **All exhibitors must be academically eligible to exhibit his/her project. Exhibitors academically ineligible "NO PASS NO PLAY" are ineligible to participate.**

2. There will be two age divisions. Age will be determined as of August 31, 2007.

Junior - 13 years and under

Senior - 14 years and older

3. Only one product may be entered in the Show. Entry fee will be \$10. One of the following categories must be checked, and **can not** be changed after the entry date:

COOKIES

- A. Drop, Rolled, or Shaped - no less than 2 ½ to 3 dozen
- B. Sheet or Bars - no less than 20 bars

CAKES

- A. Frosted Cakes - layered, oblong, tube or bundt; cakes must be frosted, iced or glazed
- B. Unfrosted Cakes - pound, bundt, loaf, etc.; NO frosting, powdered sugar, or glaze.
- C. Decorated Cakes - any type of frosted cake with piped icing decorations, decorations must be edible

PIES

- A. Fruit and/or Nut - use discretion in selecting recipe with reference to ingredients that need refrigeration for food safety. No prepared pie crusts.

BREADS

- A. Yeast - sweet or non-sweet yeast breads (ie: dinner, sweet or cinnamon rolls, loaf bread, pretzels, etc.)
- B. Quick - any non-yeast bread (ie: fruit and nut breads, coffee cakes, muffins, biscuits, cornbread, etc.)

** Rolls and muffins need to include at least 1 dozen.**

CANDY

- A. Fudge - 2-3 dozen pieces
- B. Candy- other than fudge; 2-3 dozen pieces

4. All products must be made from a recipe. **CONTESTANTS CAN NOT USE PREPARED MIXES AS MAIN INGREDIENT.** Alcohol can NOT be used in any recipe.

5. ALL COOKIES, CAKES, PIES & BREAD MUST BE BAKED! CANDY MUST BE COOKED. No item should be entered which requires refrigeration or chilling after baking (for food safety). Caution should be taken in choosing recipes with questionable food safety.

6. Write or type the complete recipe on a small sheet of paper (**3 X 5 index card preferred**) with the name of the recipe at the top. Attach to the top of the entry.

7. Contestants name should not appear anywhere on the entry.

8. Entries must be prepared and displayed according to the recipe. Added garnishes must be edible and included in the recipe.

9. Containers cannot be decorated, and must be disposable. Container will be sold with item, and NOT RETURNED! Pies may be baked and entered in glass or tin pie plates. All entries must be covered.

10. A screening committee of judges will decide whether a product will be placed or not.

11. Ribbons will be awarded. First place winners in each division will be eligible to have their products judged for Category Champion and Reserve Champion. Second place item from the class that furnished the category champion will compete for Reserve Category Champion.

12. 1ST THRU 8TH Place items in each category will be sold in auction. Non-Auctioned items may be sold via private treaty.

13. ***NEW*** Exhibitors must be present, and check-in with Auction/Exhibitor Line-Up Committee before their project's item number is due to sale. All projects must sell in the order as determined by the Sales List. Any Exhibitor not present when

their project is called for the sale will not be allowed to sale in the auction.

14. Although a complete recipe does not have to be displayed for judging, it must be brought for the auction (ie: 2 ½ dozen cookies might make a more attractive display, but if the recipe yields 4 dozen, all 4 dozen should be sold.)

15. The Bake Show will be held **November 10, 2007**. All products must be entered and ready for judging by designated time. Each contestant must bring his/her entry. If, due to a school extra-curricular activity, a participant is unable to check-in their item between 12:00 - 1:00 p.m., they must contact the Bake Show Superintendent (**Laura Crist at 751-3732**) to make arrangements to enter the item earlier that day.
