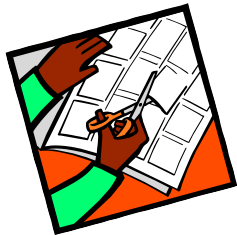

These projects are September to May – please bring collections to County Council Meeting each month!



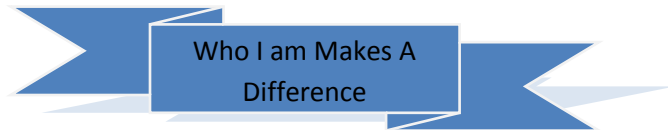
Coupons for Fort Hood
