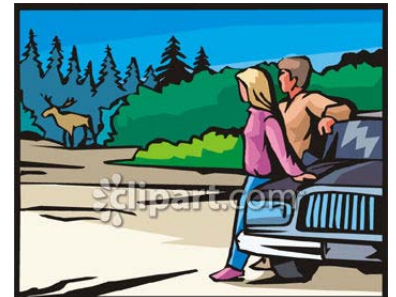


A GOLDEN DAY FOR NATURE
